COURSE DESCRIPTION

COURSE #HSC0003: Basic Healthcare Worker - 90 HOURS

**Introduction to Health Science Education
(90hours)**

In this introductory course students will demonstrate a knowledge of the health care delivery system and health occupations, medical terminology, the ability to use interpersonal skills, legal and ethical responsibilities, an understanding (and application) of wellness and disease concepts; computer literacy, a knowledge of blood borne diseases, including AIDS, and employability skills.

COURSE #HSP0330: Home Health Aide - 75 HOURS

The student will be able to obtain specified information from patients and family members. Use verbal and written information to assist with patient's care plan. Recognize and report signs of abuse, physical verbal and substance abuse. They will be able to perform physical comfort and safety functions such as maintain a clean and safe home environment.
